- Remember high cost courses (\$100 or more*) must be paid in full at the time of lodgement of course selection sheets. It is important if these are certificate courses, completed over two years. You may need this to get your WACE.**
- Outstanding high cost course fees (\$100 or more) from Year 11, 2020 will be required to be paid in full before students are considered for enrolment in high cost courses (\$100 or more) for 2021.**
