Dear Parent/Guardian

It is my pleasure to invite you to attend the Graduation Ceremony of Belridge Secondary College and Belridge Secondary Education Support Centre on Thursday 28 October 2021. It will be held at the **Kingsway Christian College Auditorium, 157 Kingsway, Darch, 6065**. Students need to arrive no later than 6.15pm and report to their form tutor to facilitate organisational matters (*see important information attached*).

This invitation is dependent upon the student having met the following conditions:

- Has completed their secondary schooling and/or achieved the requirements for WACE; and
- Maintained Good Standing status.

All outstanding books must be returned and all school charges should be paid by Friday 22 October. Students will be issued with a clearance form during a special assembly on Monday 11 October in order to facilitate this.

All graduating students will be presented with a folder containing their Belridge Secondary College graduation certificate, official photo and other relevant material.

All graduating students are required to wear academic gowns. As this is a formal occasion, students should be dressed appropriately. For example, dress shirt (tie optional), trousers and shoes for males and modest dresses, skirts and blouses for females. It is recommended that female graduates wear flat shoes and knee length skirt/dress, due to access to the stage.

Gowns must be collected from the College's Staff Room, access via the ramp in the Staff Carpark at the front of the school, between the hours of 9am and 1pm on Thursday 28 October.

Students will initially be allocated two tickets per family at a cost of \$25 per ticket. Additional tickets will be released to purchase on a first-come first-served basis. A text message will be sent when extra tickets are to be released. Tickets are for immediate family only i.e. parents/grandparents. Any requests for external guests i.e. boyfriend/girlfriend will need to be approved by Ms Holliday in advance.

The price of your ticket includes a welcome cold or hot beverage of tea/coffee and canapés upon arrival.

Tickets will be available for students to purchase from the front office during **recess** and **lunchtime** only from **Wednesday, 1st September**. It is also important to note that tickets **must** be presented at the door in order to gain entry. The last date for ticket purchase is **Wednesday, 13th October 2021**.

A statement of any outstanding compulsory school fees has recently been mailed. Any outstanding charges and contributions should be paid prior to collecting the gown, including graduation cost of \$55. Students who have already paid will be considered to have RSVP'd to the evening. Please address any questions or concerns regarding fees to the front office.

- Gowns and sashes must be collected from the Staff Room, access via the ramp in the Staff Carpark at the front of the school, between 9am and 1pm (only) on Thursday 28 October - day of graduation.
- Students must arrive no later than 6.15pm wearing gown and sash and report to their Form Tutor to facilitate organisational matters.
- The price of your ticket includes a welcome hot or cold beverage and canapés upon arrival.
- Doors open to theatre 6:45pm.
- Ceremony commences 7:00pm.
- Students are initially permitted to purchase a maximum of 2 tickets per family.
- Extra tickets will then be released to purchase on a first-come first-served basis and will be subject to any COVID-19 restrictions that may be in place at the time.
- Tickets are issued for immediate family only i.e. parents/grandparents.
- Tickets must be presented at the door in order to gain entry on the night.
- Apart from graduates and guests undertaking presentations, there will be no reserved or numbered seating in venue to enable families to sit together.
- Following the graduation ceremony students are required to return gowns to their Form Teacher. Students will be directed accordingly by staff on the night.

- Auditorium location is marked with a **X**
- Parents and guest entry will be via the marquee located to the left of the auditorium entrance (between blocks Music and Woodwork S44). This will take you through to the courtyard waiting area and entrance to auditorium.

There is ample parking as circled on the map.

- Entry to Kingsway Christian College is via Hartman Drive/Westport Parade or Kingsway/Carripan Road.
- Entrance to the large carpark is via Carripan Road. Exit is on Westport Parade.
- There is also street parking around the venue.
- Please do not park on the oval or in the first carpark off Westport Parade as this is for venue staff only.
- All car parks are a very short walk to the auditorium.
