Background

Course Description

Lower School

At all schools the four hour per week course covers:

- Modified games/indoor cricket
- Interschool matches
- Interstate and international tours

Upper School

All schools offer Upper School University and TAFE bound courses to meet student needs. This includes the Physical Education Studies Course of Study and Certificate III in Sport.

Parents and students will be notified whether or not they have been selected into the program within four weeks of attending their trials.

Parents are welcome to stay at the ground throughout the afternoon. It is essential that you attend the closing session where aspects of student/parent commitment and requirements to be a part of the Cricket Course will be outlined.
