## **Elite Music Program**



# WHY JUST LISTEN? WHEN YOU CAN CREATE?

Music has been a part of the Belridge community since the school opened in 1991. The elite music program offers passionate and talented young musicians the opportunity to delve deeper in the inner workings of music, develop their instrumental skills through the IMSS (Instrumental Music School Services) program and experience a range of performance outlets through solos opportunities, the school band, guitar ensemble or choir.

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- While our Elite Music Program runs from Year 7 to 12, this form is for students seeking to join the program in Year 7. Students interested in joining in other years should contact Mr Offszanka directly, either in person, or at E: <a href="mailto:zachary.Offszank@education.wa.edu.au">zachary.Offszank@education.wa.edu.au</a>
- Applicants can be experienced students or beginners. Regardless, all students selected are required to engage in regular instrumental lessons. This can be either through application to the school based IMSS (Instrumental Music School Services) program, on site private voice/piano lessons or out of school tuition. Students are expected to commit to a minimum of 2 full years in the program.
- The program is **open to all students (from beginners to advanced) in Year 7 to 11.** Students who are selected may or may not have had music tuition previously though all students selected are required to engage in regular instrumental lessons. This can be either through the school based IMSS program, on site private voice/piano lessons or out of school tuition. Students are expected to commit to a minimum of 2 full years in the program.
- o The program includes 2 classroom lessons and, if taking instrumental lessons through the school, 1 instrumental lesson per week. Classroom lessons will focus on musicianship (aural and theory), music history and analysis, solo and ensemble performance and composition. Over the course of the program, students will study Western art (classical) music, jazz, contemporary and world music.
- o If your child is accepted into the Elite Music Program, they are eligible to have lessons through the Instrumental lesson program (IMSS). Instrumental lessons are given by the Instrumental Music School Services, which provides free weekly lessons by the Department of Education of Western Australia on site. Hire instruments are available for \$120\* for the first year of lessons. Vocal and piano lessons are also available through a visiting private tutor who charges a per lesson fee.
- o The allocation of instrumental tuition opportunities will be determined by the availability of each instrument, the needs of the current program, and the student's preferences. While every effort will be made to ensure all students in the program are offered an instrument to learn through IMSS, this may not always be possible as it is dependent on the availability of IMSS teachers for the school and the classes they allocate us.
- o Students wanting instrumental lessons at Belridge **must** be enrolled in the Elite Music Program and preference for vocal and piano lessons will be given to students enrolled with the program.
- o If your child is accepted into the Elite Music Program they will have the opportunity to join the school's concert band and choir, both of which perform regularly at school concerts. Guitar students will also be able to join the schools' guitar ensemble.
