Section A: Clothing Design

You will find enclosed one croquis outline for you to use as a tracing guide. Place an A4 sheet of paper over the top of the croquis and draw your design using pencil.

Colour the design using any medium you wish (pencil, texta, paint, fabrics etc.)

Create a design for each of the following categories.

- 1. Street Wear: e.g. suitable for going out to meet family and friends
- 2. **Sports Wear:** e.g. suitable for the beach, team sports such as netball and football, exercise wear for the gym or dance wear.
- 3. **Evening:** e.g. suitable for cocktail wear, formal wear, ball or bridal wear.
- 4. Fantasy: e.g. Science fiction, mystical creatures. In a short paragraph also explain your inspiration for this design (no more than 5 lines).

Note:

All designs need to be original and not copied from books, movies or the internet.

This section requires you to draw from observation which means that you draw real objects that you can see and touch. Examples of these are flowers and leaves, chocolate bar and wrapper, toothpaste and brush.

Please complete **three** A4 sized drawings from observation. The subject matter is your choice but try to choose objects that have a lot of detail because even though these may seem difficult to draw, they will hold a lot of 'information' that your eye will see and your hand converts into lines and shapes. You may add colour if you wish.


