Health and Physical Education – Expectations and Agreement

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome to the new school year. We seek your support in maintaining a well-organised and engaging Health and Physical Education (HPE) program. Please review the expectations below with your child and ensure you are aware of the days they have Physical Education scheduled.

Student Expectations

All students are required to:

- Wear the correct PE uniform: Red PE shirt with black or navy-blue shorts or track pants. A change of clothes is essential for hygiene, weather conditions, and to protect regular school attire.
- Participate fully in all activities: Belridge SC operates in all weather conditions. Students will be sheltered only when conditions are unsafe.
- Provide prior notice if unable to participate: A written note or phone call is required for non-participation due to illness, injury, or lack of uniform. In such cases, students will assist with scoring, umpiring, note-taking, or light activity.
